**SOURDOUGH PANCAKES WITH HONEY BUTTER AND FRESH BERRIES..... \$9.75**

In Washington, sourdough pancakes are a tradition from the days of the Alaskan Gold Rush. The prospectors used so much batter they were known as “Sourdoughs.” At The Paradise Inn, our pancakes are made with stone ground flour and served with honey butter and fresh seasonal berries

**HONEY CURED HAM STEAK AND EGGS..... \$10.00**

We serve a thick, half pound, grilled honey cured ham steak with fresh cage free eggs cooked to order. Apple cured bacon or link sausage can be substituted for ham steak. Served with crispy hash browns and toast

**SMOKED SALMON AND ASPARAGUS OMELET ..... \$12.75**

There are many species of salmon in the cold waters of the North Pacific. Chinook or King Salmon is our favorite. The chefs at Paradise lightly smoke King Salmon with red cedar and make an omelet using grilled asparagus, cage free eggs and Havarti cheese. Served with crispy hash browns and toast

**CAMP MUIR FRENCH TOAST ..... \$10.25**

For the last forty years we have been serving our ‘Camp Muir’ French Toast at Paradise Inn. Thick slices of crusty French bread are soaked in an egg batter flavored with nutmeg, cinnamon and vanilla then finished with chopped Oregon filberts. Served with house made blackberry syrup, whole butter and fresh seasonal fruit

Tillamook cheddar cheese egg strata with peppers and onions, crispy hash brown potatoes, bacon and sausage, whole fruit, fresh baked pastries, hot oatmeal with golden raisins and slivered almonds, fresh juice and your choice of coffee, tea, or milk
